- Electric transmission business regulated by FERC

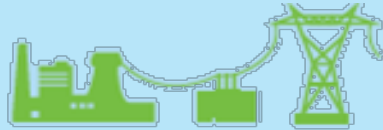

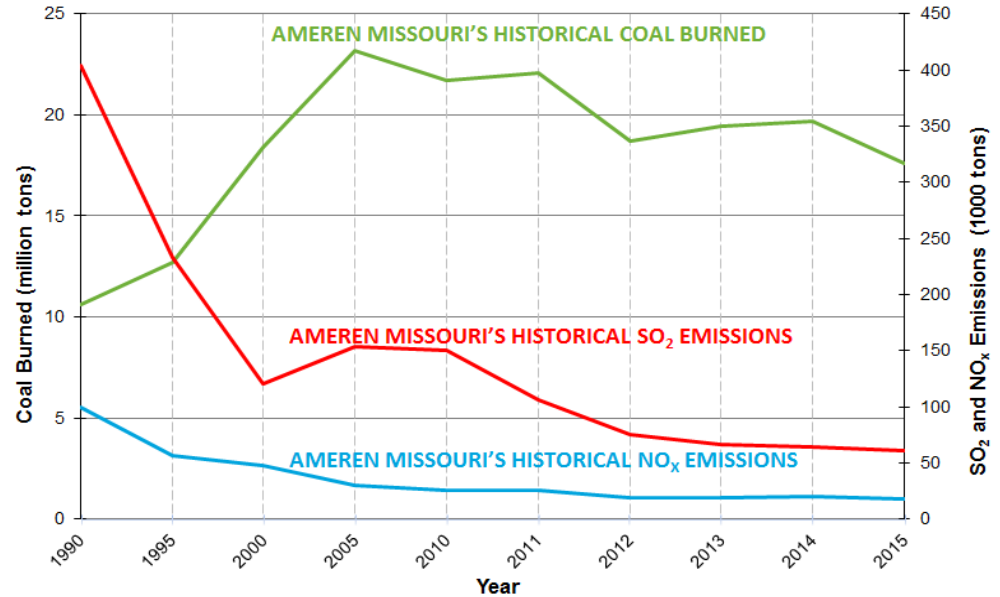

*Ameren Missouri carbon dioxide, nitrogen oxide and sulfur dioxide emissions for calendar year 2015 compared to 2011.

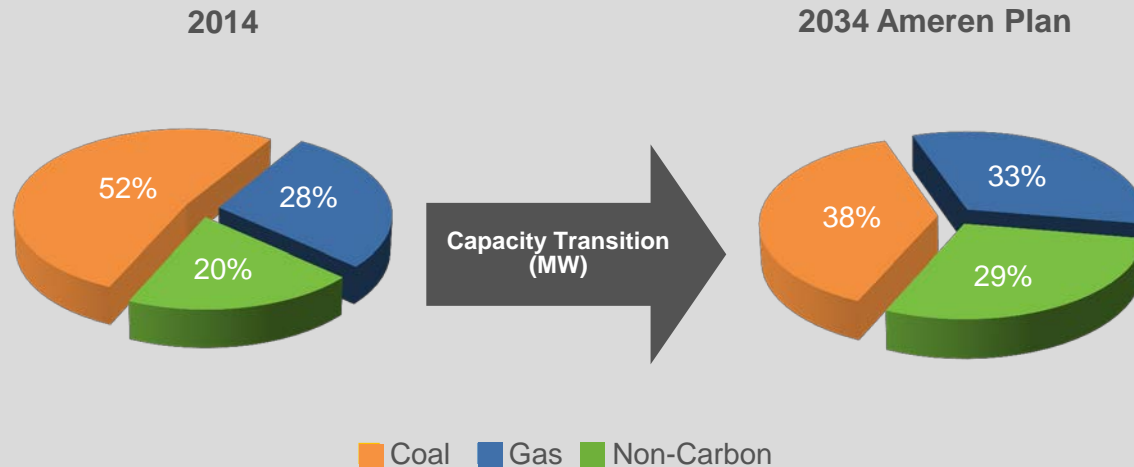

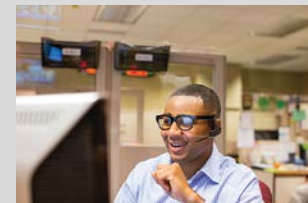

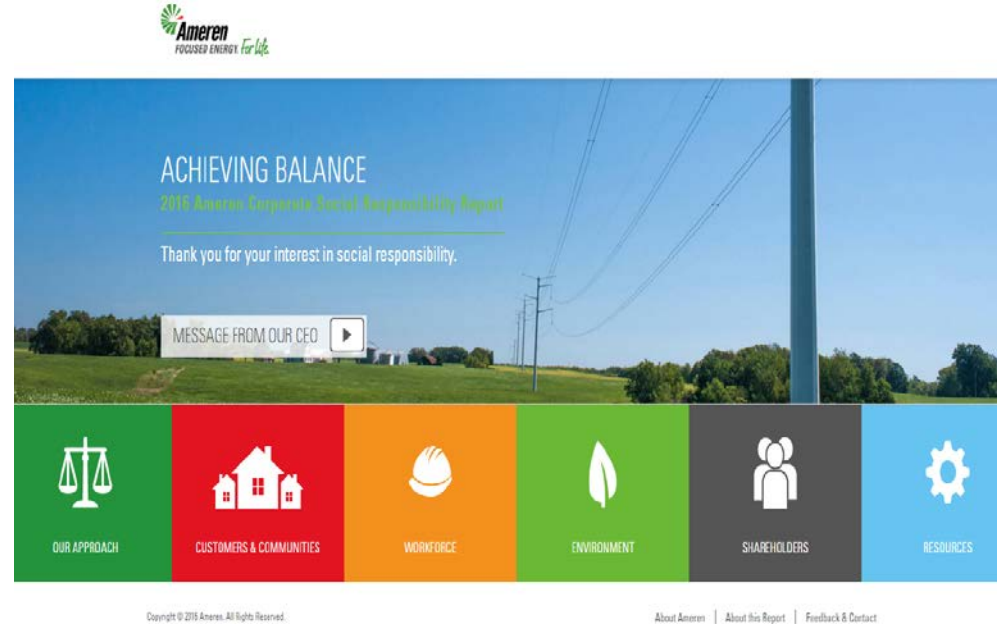
